- 4 - 9 voices

SATURDAY PROGRAMME

CONTEMPORARY VOCAL (Amplified Voice) DISCIPLINE

- Solo & Ensemble (2-4 voices) sections

MUSICAL THEATRE DISCIPLINE

- Solo & Ensemble (2-4 voices) sections

VOCAL DISCIPLINE

- Solo (Classical & non-classical) & Ensemble (2-4 voices) sections,
- Vocal Scholarship for age 15-20 years entered in Vocal Classical Solo

INSTRUMENTAL DISCIPLINE (Other than piano)

- Instrumental Solo (*This includes a Novice section for 1st instrument only*), & Ensemble (2-4 instruments) sections
