## WILLIAM ARTHUR HERBERT HEWETT 01.11.1927 - 11.03.2011

Bill, or "Kamaru" as he was known to members of the Scouting movement, was a dedicated community member most remembered as the local 1st Balaklava Scout Leader and 'Barossa and Light' District Commissioner. Life Membership was awarded in 1990 for his many years of service to Scouting.

His greatest passion however was choral singing. He was a member of the Gawler Choral Society, the Gawler-Barossa Oratorio Choir, Balaklava Music Lovers' Choral Society, Balaklava Community Arts and the Adelaide Plains Male Voice Choir.
