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NOTES FOR ALL SATURDAY DISCIPLINES

* PLEASE READ FIRST *

- Depending on number of entries, some SECTIONS may be divided, combined, cancelled or have entries CLOSED EARLY when capacity is reached.
- Total entries are limited to maximum of <u>FIVE</u> or less per individual.
- > Ensembles/Groups may be entered only ONCE in each discipline see Rule 6.
- EACH member of an ensemble or group except large group drama (sd5-9) <u>MUST complete</u> an entry form and pay a \$6 entry fee.
- > Large Drama groups (sd5-9) are only required to complete <u>one</u> form and pay a single \$20 fee.
- COPYRIGHT The OneMusic (APRA|AMCOS) (for all music sections) and the Speech & Drama (only for Speech & Drama sections) <u>COPYRIGHT PERFOMER DECLARATION</u> forms can be downloaded directly from the website Forms page.
 - The entrant must complete ONE form only for ALL applicable sections of the declaration form. Present the copyright declaration form on the day of performance at each booking in office (i.e., one form for all music venues &/or one form for Speech & Drama).
 - Do NOT send this form beforehand.

- PHOTOGRAPHING: Photos may be taken at the END of your family member's performance. NO photographs to be taken DURING a performance.
- FILMING/RECORDING: To video an individual performance of your child only, a <u>Domestic Video</u> <u>Licence</u> must be presented at the booking in office. A videographer badge for the day will be supplied. Licence is available online at <u>https://form.jotform.co/MediaLicensing/DVL.</u>
 - For enquires re obtaining a domestic video licence ring **OneMusic** (formerly APRA|AMCOS) on 1300 852 388 or email <u>nonretlic@apra.com.au</u>
 - No videos may be made without a licence See Rule 21 (b) re audio-visual licensing.
- Photo disclaimer: The society reserves the right to take photos to use for publicity purposes on their website, social media and local media. Please advise if any entrants require exclusion from this use of photographs.
- In all sections where words are used, all lyrics must be provided together with original or authorised copies of music and be presented at each booking in office. Receipts for downloaded music may be requested for viewing.
- Part of your adjudication is your preparation for performance. A high standard of personal presentation is considered desirable, and will be taken into consideration by the Adjudicator. Entrants must be sensitive to mixed audiences, ages and venues.
- The Adjudicator reserves the right to terminate a performance and/or disqualify a performer if the performance includes offensive language or content. Refer Rule 19 re conduct and content.
- At the end of each section, collect your named original music/written works and your certificate and adjudicators comments.
- > Wherever possible, be present at the end of that section for presentations.
- > If entering the Vocal Scholarship **Rule 8** applies, including performing different pieces.

- > A **LEGIBLE COPY OF THE LYRICS** must be provided for the Adjudicator.
- > Use of microphone is preferred but not mandatory. Adjudication includes microphone technique.
- Accompaniment can be original or authorised backing track or live accompaniment. Preferred form of backing track is on USB. If competitor is using live accompaniment, original or authorised sheet music needs to be sighted by the booking-in staff. Show receipt for online music purchases.
- NAME your backing track storage device (e.g., USB), indicate song name and track number when booking in. Collect at the end of the section, along with certificate and adjudicator's comments.
- Ensure that any backing vocals are less prominent than the performer. Backing must not contain lead vocals.

- > Have all **original or authorised sheet music** ready for booking-in. Music must include lyrics.

- > Have all original or authorised sheet music ready for booking-in. Music must include lyrics
- Note: Print Music Any downloaded print music from the internet is to be presented with evidence of 'authorization for use' including receipts, and must be sighted by the booking in staff
- NO costumes or props or microphones to be used

The \$1000 scholarship has been set up to assist the winner in paying tuition fees of a recognised Vocal Teacher, sponsored by the APMVC Inc. and assisted by Lyndoch Motors and Balco Australia.

- Performance will include a Vocal Classical Solo plus a Musical Theatre Solo as a <u>contrasting piece</u> demonstrating versatility. See criteria for Vocal Classical and Musical Theatre music. Neither pieces are to have been performed in any other section, as per Rule 8.
- The Adelaide Plains Male Voice Choir Vocal Scholarship is open to any person between the ages of 15 years and 20 years on 1st July 2023. Entering in the Vocal Discipline's Vocal Classical Solo Section of the Balaklava Eisteddfod is <u>encouraged</u> but not mandatory.
- In all sections where words are used, all lyrics must be provided together with original or authorised sheet music. Receipts for downloaded sheet music may be requested for sighting.
- Performers are encouraged to use <u>live accompaniment</u>. <u>No vocal amplification</u>.
 *** The same criteria/rules re accompaniment in the Vocal Discipline apply for the vocal classical piece.

If an accompanist is unavailable, the entrant may use a backing track consisting of <u>ONE instrument only</u> for the vocal classical piece. The musical theatre piece does not have this restriction re backing track. If using a backing track, the entrant must **bring and operate own named playing device**, including external speakers.

The winner of the Scholarship will be expected to perform at one or two Adelaide Plains Male Voice Choir concerts during the tenure of the scholarship - Refer to the Vocal Scholarship information letter and application form on the website for more details.

GENERAL NOTES FOR ALL SPEECH & DRAMA SECTIONS

- A legible copy of the Context Statement or Synopsis and original script for any Recitation/Drama piece to be performed MUST be provided for the Adjudicator
- NOTE Entries Rule 6 and Performance Rules 8-11 and Rule 19 re conduct and content
- COPYRIGHT DECLARATION for SPEECH & DRAMA USE ONLY is to be filled in and presented to Booking In staff on the day of competition. Spare forms will be available at the venue.

PROSE &/OR POETRY READING - *NOT MEMORISED*

MATERIAL:	A reading from a section of prose (novel/ newspaper/ magazine etc.)
	and/or a poetry reading

- TIME LIMIT: 5 minutes PLUS brief introduction time
- > A copy of the section of prose or poetry to be read is to be handed in at the booking-in office for the adjudicator
- In the Prose or Poetry Reading sections, an entrant may perform a Prose Reading OR a Poetry Reading. You may only enter this section once.
- If you wish to do both a prose & a poetry reading, then they must fit within one the 5-minute time frame, as one entry
- Sections may be divided or combined depending on numbers of entries.

RECITATION SOLO

MATERIAL:	A memorised recital of a poem or section of prose
TIME LIMIT:	5 minutes
<u>OR</u>	
DRAMA SOLO	
MATERIAL:	A <u>memorised</u> monologue or a solo section from a play / script Simple costumes and props may be used
TIME LIMIT:	<u>5 minutes</u> PLUS brief set up time

NOTE *

- In the Solo Drama or Recitation sections an entrant may perform a Recitation Solo OR a Drama Solo (monologue). You may only enter this section once.
- If you wish to do both a recitation & a drama performance, then they must fit within one 5-minute time frame, as one entry
- Recitation and Drama Performance Solos will be combined in the one section (sd) UNLESS there are sufficient numbers of each to warrant separation.

- Only ONE form is required for the large Group Drama with 5-9 performers. There is a specific separate entry form to be filled in online. Payment for this section (sd5-9) is a single \$20 fee for the named group. Put the name of the group (as it will be printed in the programme), NOT of name of the piece to be performed.
