WELCOME to our 29th Balaklava Eisteddfod. We look forward to seeing you all on Friday 1st and Saturday 2nd August 2025.

PROGRAM: Printed programs are not being posted this year but will be available from the Eisteddfod Office at the Balaklava Town Hall and at all venues on the Balaklava Eisteddfod weekend and beforehand at the Balaklava Post Office, the Balaklava Community Library and Whimsical Cafe for **\$5.00** each. A pdf version of the program will be uploaded in due course.

<u>COPYRIGHT & BOOKING IN</u>: All entrants MUST complete a <u>Copyright Performer Declaration</u> Form. These MUST be presented at each venue's booking-in office along with original materials. All singing sections require a legible copy of the lyrics.

- ONE Declaration Form only is needed per entrant for music performances.
- Please list all performance pieces on page 2 of the form, in order of the disciplines/sections they will be performed. Note in which section the pieces will be performed (e.g. cv, mt, inst)

See the website <u>Forms</u> page for the "One Music" (APRAJAMCOS) Copyright Declaration Forms for any <u>musical performance</u>. * If you can't bring a pre-filled form, there will be spare forms at each venue.

<u>MICROPHONES</u>: NO vocal amplification is to be used in any disciplines except for Rock Band, Stage Band and Contemporary Vocal.
